Successful Supervision with Community Health Workers* aims to build the capacity of Supervisors to provide more responsive and informed supervision for the CHWs on their team. Workshop participants will learn about available resources and apply practical tools designed to improve supervisory practices.

These workshops focus on key areas identified and prioritized by CHW Supervisors and informed by insights from subject matter experts in community health, education, and related fields.

In order to be responsive to emerging needs, CHI is incorporating content relevant to the CHW role as it relates to the current public health, social and economic context.

Cost & Eligibility: Participants will have no out of pocket costs. Individuals who currently supervise CHWs (or the supervisors of CHWs) and who are employed at a **MassHealth ACO** or **Community Partner (CP)**, or an associated entity, are eligible to apply. CHI will work with Commonwealth Corporation and MassHealth to approve participants consistent with the goals of MassHealth DSRIP.
